Swimmers ready for states

The state swimming and diving championships get under way Wednesday at Bucknell University.

Class AAA events will be held Wednesday and Thursday this year, followed by AA action on Friday and Saturday.

As the swimmers toned down their training since districts, probably the toughest thing was the waiting.

"The biggest thing for the girls and the guys is to stay focused," Souderton Area coach

Todd Bauer said. "It's a continuation of districts, so you need to stay focused for another week and a half. It's like any sport, where if you make it to the finals and if you fail once you get there, it's for not, so you want to prepare as best you can."

Paige Whitmire is one of the swimmers making it back to states.

"I know how I prepared for it last year," the Souderton junior said. "I just got pysched up, and that's all I can do. There's nothing else I can do but wait and oper ready."

Whitmire will have a busy two days, competing in the 50 free, and the 100 back, where she is seeded second. She will also swim on a couple relays.

Souderton has a good number of girls going this year, including Angela Severn (200 free and 100 free), Mariel Kush (200 and 500 free), Missy Doll (50 free), and all three relays are going to Bucknell.

The Souderton boys have Jake Raddliff in the 500 free and Tim Dorsch in the 100 breast

North Penn will also be well-represented, especially in the diving, as Julia Tate makes a return trip to Bucknell, joined by fellow diver Laurie McLaughlin. The Knights have three divers going - Zac Nees, Frankie Murray and Mike Kohler.

North Penn swimmers making the trip include Dan Dingman (200 and 500 free), Nico Gimenez (200 IM and 100 breast), Jeff Smallwood (100 fly), Jack Else (500 free), and two relays on the boys side. The Maidens have Sam Deana in the 50 free, Jan Ikeda in the 100 fly, Lauren French in the 100 free, Becca Hannings in the 500 free, and all three relays.

Methacton's Blair Kinsey (200 IM and 100 breast) and Kristen Rodman (50



and 100 free), and the Warriors' 400 free relay will be competing.

Other area boys competing include Pennridge's Dave Apple (100 fly), Wissahickon's medley and 200 free relay teams, Methacton's Andrew Gerland (100 fly and 100 free), CB West's Pierre LeCorre (500 free) and Sean Cook (100 back), and Wissahickon's Adam Bossert (100 free and 100 breast).
