North Penn and Pennridge high schools finished the first day of the District 1 Class AAA girls' swimming championship Thursday at La Salle atop the standings and in the record books.

North Penn's 200-meter relay team of Kailyn Evans, Aimee Baur, Leah Brown, and Olivia DiStefano established a meet record when they touched in 1 minute, 34.63 seconds.

The Vikings finished with 197 points, 100 ahead of second-place Pennridge, which set two records and tied another.

Morgan Scott established a meet record in the 200 freestyle (1:49.95). Hannah Zurmuhl tied the meet record in the 50 freestyle (23.30 seconds).

In AA, it was all Villa Maria, which recorded 300 points, nearly twice that of second-place Nazareth Academy's 156.

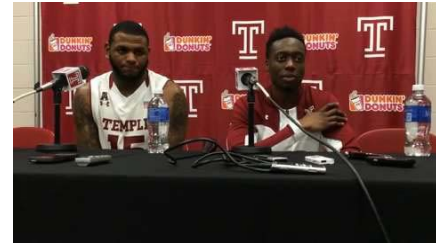
