t What he's done: Scholl ran for a game-high 152 yards and three touchdowns on 15 carries as he helped the Indians knock off undefeated Central Bucks West 34-24 in a Suburban One League Continental Conference contest last Friday.

Scholl put Souderton on the board in the first quarter with a 41-yard touchdown run. He added another score in the quarter on a 10-yard run, then found the end zone again in the third on a four-yard run.

Through four games, Scholl has compiled 409 yards rushing — second in the area — and has scored eight touchdowns.

t What's next: Souderton (2-2, 1-0 conference) hosts Pennridge in a SOL Continental matchup 7 p.m. Friday. The Indians have defeated the Rams in the the teams' last two meetings, including a 27-7 victory last season.

t What's he said: "This was our most important game so far," said Scholl after the win last Friday. "It was a must-win. We didn't want to be 1-3."

t Honorable Mention: Brendan Pinder (Lansdale Catholic soccer) scored four goals — two in each half — in the Crusaders' 8-0 win over Neumann-Goretti last Wednesday; Jack Morris (North Penn water polo) scored a match-high six goals as the Knights topped Wissahickon 14-8 last Tuesday; Brandon Bossard (Methacton football) threw for 97 yards and ran for touchdowns on two, nine and one yards as the Warriors defeated Spring-Ford 25-20 last Saturday.
