Athlete of the week: North Penn water polo player Kevin Dunigan

The week that was: Kevin combined with cousin Pat Dunigan for nine goals in a 14-8 victory over La Salle to help the Knights finish fifth in the Pennsylvania Boys Water Polo Championships at North Penn on Nov. 5-6. North Penn finished its season 24-4.

In his words: "We started out good on Friday night against (Erie) Cathedral Prep. We picked it up and eventually beat them. Our next game was Governor Mifflin, (which) we'd beaten two times recently, but I think we were worried about the number one seed. We came out really good against the number one seed, (eventual champion) Wilson. Our fifth place game against La Salle, we started out slow but finished fast."

In his coach's words: "He came out big for us. He scored a couple of timely goals when it was pretty close in the second half. It was a pretty big victory there. He was part of our main offensive output for that game. Kevin scored four of those goals. He was a first-year starter for us. As a first-year starter, he was one of our main offensive threats.
